What The 16th-annual **National Learn to Row Day** will take place on **Saturday, June 3, 2017**, in rowing clubs and health clubs throughout the United States.

Great Salt Lake Rowing (GSLR), your Salt Lake City-area sponsor, will host this **FREE** public event intended to give participants a **“taste of rowing”**!

Who Everyone age 13-99 interested in rowing
Those under age 18 need a guardian/parent present to sign the waiver and the youth must be physically able to safely fit in and be able to row the boat

Where Great Salt Lake Marina – South end @ small boat docks

Note: A \$3.00/car fee will be charged by UT State Parks @ GSL Marina entrance. Park at South (left) parking lot near Maintenance Building. Carpooling is advised, as parking space is limited.

Directions SaltAir Exit 104 from I-80 Westbound, then frontage road westbound past SaltAir to Utah State Parks and Recreation marina entrance (fee station), then South (left) along marina to event – watch for the Great Salt Lake Rowing **National Learn to Row Day** banners!
